Item 1: Call to Order and Roll Call

Meeting called to order at 10:30 with Chair Roosen, Vice Chair Sieglen-Perry, Members Wolford, Jackson, Landon, and Koczur present; Members Cooluris and Zuno absent. Member Kate Pecora arrived at 10:40.

Item 2: Non-Agenda Public Comment

Item 3: Approval of the draft minutes of January 8, 2025

Member Landon motioned with Member Vice Chair Sieglen-Perry seconding, to approve the minutes of January 8, 2025. Passed unanimously with Members and Cooluris, Zuno and Pecora absent.

Item 4: Information Item: Mobility Master Plan (Phil Trom, Program Manager, Sustainability and Mobility Department)

Mr. Trom provided an overview of the of the Draft Mobility Master Plan. The City's Active Transportation and Infrastructure Committee will review at its February meeting. Mr. Trom initially presented the Draft Mobility Master Plan in February 2024 to the Accessibility Advisory Board (AAB) and provided an update October 2024. Member Sieglen-Perry thanked Mr. Trom for including the AAB board's notes and comments into the final version. Member Wolford asked if there was any possibility to move bike lanes on 30th Street onto the next parallel residential street. Member Pecora asked if it would be possible for the AAB board to have a permanent seat on the Mobility Board, staff let her know there is mandatory ADA representation on the Mobility Board and that is held currently by Wayne Landon who also sits on AAB.

Item 5: Adoption of the Federal Public Rights of Way Accessibility Guidelines (PROWAG) for Transportation Facilities (Alejandra Warner, Access Compliance Specialist, ADA Compliance and Accessibility, Sustainability and Mobility Department, City of San Diego)

Ms. Warner provided an overview of PROWAG stating it became effective on January 17, 2025, and is applicable only to Transportation Facilities such as of transit stops, boarding areas, accessible routes and shelters benches.

Member Wolford suggested to open a dialogue with MTS about changes due to PROWAG. Ms. Warner stated that we will coordinate with the Transportation Department's MTS liaison. Member Sieglen-Perry offered that the AAB board could write a letter if needed. Chair Roosen proposed to open a new Transportation Ad Hoc Committee.
